
- Mondays @ 2pm in Library Park, 209 E Center Street

*Children ages 5 & under must be accompanied by an adult.



Join us back in the Madison Public Library every Monday. These drop-in events run from 4-6pm. *Children ages 5 & under must be accompanied by an adult.




